




All Enrolled Students Trend by IPEDS Ethnicity/Race





Hispanic/Latino Student Enrollment Trend






■ State General Fund ■ Tuition and Fees




GRANTS, CONTRACTS, AND GIFTS

► Grants and contract expenditures have increased

from \$60.8 million in FY14 to an estimated \$78 million in FY17

- ➤ Our donors helped us exceed our first-ever comprehensive campaign goal of \$100 million and they are helping us lay the groundwork for a renewed outreach campaign.
- ► Annual distribution of private gifts to NAU increased from \$13.8 million to \$18 million in the last three fiscal years.
- ► Fiscal years 2016 and 2017 were the **best fundraising years** in the history of our university.
